CLUB PROTOCOLS

Financial Membership

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) sets the annual subscription.

Options for Payment of Subscription

1. Subscriptions for the ensuing year can be paid anytime from the date of the AGM.
2. Members can pay their subscription in one payment and receive the discounted rate if paid before 31 January.
3. Instalments can be paid through automatic payments or cash. To qualify for the discounted rate the full amount must be paid before 31 January.
4. Any arrangements to pay subscriptions by instalment past 31 January will attract the full subscription. Default on any payments that form part of this arrangement will void the arrangement and Rule 17 will be applied.
5. Only members who are financial at 31 January will be eligible for selection for interclub teams. Members who have made arrangements to pay by instalment will be deemed financial but are reminded of point 4 above.
6. Members who do not renew their subscription each year are not entitled to use the course or club house facilities.
7. Subscriptions not paid by 31 March will deem the member unfinancial. Unfinancial members are not entitled to use the course or club house facilities and are not eligible to play in club trophy events from the date of being declared unfinancial.

Dress Code

Neat and tidy dress is compulsory. To maintain a standard suitable to the club, members are requested to pay attention to their dress. Badly faded, worn-out, torn or dirty clothing will

not be tolerated. Offenders will be asked to leave the club house or the golf course. All members are expected to police this rule.

Street shoes are not to be worn on the greens. It is desirable that only proper golf shoes are worn on the course.

Club House

Golf equipment should not be brought into the club house. Members are requested not to park trundlers and/or golf clubs in or around the entrance to the club house. The club accepts no responsibility for any damages to or loss of any equipment.

Liquor License Requirements

The club is licensed to sell liquor within the following hours:

Monday to Thursday	10:30am – 10:30pm;
Friday and Saturday	10:30am – 1:00am;
Sunday	10:30am – 10:00pm.

The Bar duty manager may use his/her discretion to close the bar early depending on the level of activity in the club house at the time.

These hours may only be altered with approval from the licensing authority for special activities.

Compliant with liquor licensing laws, liquor will only be sold to members and visitors 18 years of age and over.

Members and visitors are not permitted to bring their own liquor into the club house and are expected to comply with any and every instruction given by the duty bar manager.

Members may be required to produce their current membership cards and should ensure they are accessible when in the club house and on the course.

As required under the liquor license, food is available at all times. If the Restaurant is closed small microwave food packs can be provided. Ask at the bar.

Standards of Behaviour — on and off course

Members and visitors are expected to maintain a decent standard of behaviour in and about the club house and on the course. Excessive intoxication or offensive language will not be tolerated. Offenders will be barred from the club and its environs.

Parents are responsible for the behaviour of their children at all times within the environs of the course and club house. As a general rule children are not permitted in the environs of the course and club house without parental supervision.

Visitors to the club house must be accompanied by a member. It is the member's responsibility to ensure the visitor's book is signed. Members are responsible for their visitors and should ensure they and their visitors observe the rules, etiquette and protocols of the Club.

Course and Playing Etiquette

- The lowest handicap player in any four is responsible for course etiquette.
- No-one should move, talk, or stand close to or directly behind the ball or hole, when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
- The player who has the honour should be allowed to play before his opponent or fellow competitor tees his ball.
- No player should proceed until players in front are out of range.
- In the interest of all, players should play without delay. Players who lose one clear hole on the rest of the field must call following players through.

- Players searching for a ball must allow other players coming up to pass them. Immediately the search is commenced, they should signal to the players following to pass and should not continue their play until those players are out of range.
- Players should replace all divots and repair pitch marks. Care must be taken to ensure that the flagstick does not damage the green. It must be properly replaced before leaving the green.
- Trundlers and bags should not be placed on the greens or tee areas.
- When the play of the hole has been completed, players should immediately leave the putting green. Cards are **NOT** to be marked on the green or immediate surrounds.
- Members and players are not to use teeing area, fairways or greens to practice on.
- Lost property and clubs found on the course are to be handed into the club house office on that day if possible.
- Membership tags should be prominently displayed on bags or trundlers whilst on the course.
- Children are not permitted on the course unless acting as caddies or engaged in playing under supervision.
- Players are responsible for the behaviour of their caddies.
- Local Rules are to be applied in conjunction with the rules of Golf and will be displayed on the Local Rules Board.
- Any queries regarding etiquette or rules of golf are to be referred to the Match Committee IMMEDIATELY after the relevant round has been completed, except where the rules of golf require otherwise.
- All members and visitors are expected to adhere to the course and club house regulations.
- Turning at the 9th, turning players will have the right of way to proceed to the 10th tee. Turning and starting fours will integrate alternately.

Course Unplayable

The decision as to whether the course is unplayable (through bad weather or other reasons) will be made by the Course Manager and the Club Captain. On Sundays a decision will be made prior to the first tee off time and as early as possible.

Where doubt exists, members should ring either the men's or women's captain.

If the course is considered unplayable with no potential respite from the weather, then the current competition will be rescheduled, concluded or abandoned.

Course Maintenance

From time to time course maintenance may be carried out during programmed events. Greens staff have the right of way in these, and any other circumstances, and players are expected to co-operate accordingly.

Practice on the Day of Competition

Except as otherwise provided under the provisions of course etiquette, the rules of golf provide that no player shall practice on the course prior to a stroke play event. Practice fairways and putting greens may be used.

The restriction of practice on the course does not apply on the day of a match play event.

Marking of Cards and Handicapping

Handicapping is strictly in accordance with the NZ Golf Association Handicap and Course Slope Rated Systems.

In individual events, each player must mark a card. This card must be returned and include the scores of the marker, and the signatures of the player and the marker.

Handicapping depends upon full and accurate information of the player's scorecards. It is players' responsibility to check their handicaps and know their index before play commences. When visiting other clubs, players need to check the slope index at that course.

New members should seek information on the handicapping procedure from the Club Captain.

Match play cards are required to be submitted for all matches that end beyond the 12th hole. In accordance with Section 5-2 of the NZGA Handicap Index System the procedure to be used for handicap purposes only, is as follows:

- If a player starts but does not complete a hole or is conceded a stroke, the player shall record, for handicap purposes, the score they most likely would have scored. The most likely score consists of the number of strokes already taken plus, in their best judgement, the number of strokes they would need to complete the hole from that position. The number may not exceed the player's ESC limit; an 'X' should precede the most likely score.
- If a player's match has concluded and they decide not to play out the remaining holes then the score for those holes, for handicap purposes, shall be par plus any handicap strokes the player is entitled to receive on that hole.
- As with stroke play, players should ensure they include the date of play, their name, seven digit ID, handicap index, course handicap, the course played, the adjusted gross score, and, if a visitor, the name and ID of their home club.

Note: A social four-ball best ball haggie is not a match play event, but the individual players should score, for handicap purposes, as if it was a medal round.

Par and stableford competitions are primarily designed to speed up play. Players are requested to pick up immediately

when they have lost a hole to par, or in stablefords when they cannot score a point. Such holes require an assessed score to be recorded.

Hole-in-One Rules

A hole-in-one entitles a financial member to a grant of \$100 to shout for fellow members on the day of the perfect shot and for juniors a grant of \$40, provided the following conditions are complied with:

1. The member is playing in an official competition that day;
2. The player must present a completed card signed by a marker and the player; and
3. If the hole-in-one is achieved on a course other than Titahi, the member must have been representing the Titahi Golf Club or in an official sponsored Wellington or New Zealand Golf Association tournament.

Conditions of Play

In certain circumstances, it may be necessary for the Match Committee to alter dates, entry fees, and/or conditions of play, or postpone any rounds, in any event. Any alterations will be posted on the notice board.

Entry fees must be paid on the day of competition. No player playing Sunday daily competitions shall tee off before 7.00am, unless permission has been granted by the Match Committee.

Titahi Veteran's Golf

This is open to all golfers aged 50 years and over. This group meets on Thursday mornings, from mid-January to mid-December. A disc draw takes place at 9.00 am.

54 Hole Strokeplay

Three 18-hole rounds gross in divisions: Senior 0 – 9, Intermediate 10 – 13, Junior 14 – 18 and Junior B 19 – 36.

Gilligan Cup

One qualifying 18-hole round nett. A maximum of three groups of 16 to qualify followed by handicap matchplay.

Harold Williams Cup

One 18-hole round nett; opening day.

Captain's Trophy

Two out of three 18-hole rounds stableford.

Crichton Cup, Stone Alward Cup, Booth Cup

Two out of three 18-hole rounds par in divisions, Senior, Intermediate, and Junior. Divisions decided after first round.

Don Conroy Trophy

Best gross card for 18-holes on any one official competition day during season.

President's Trophy

One qualifying 18-hole round nett. Maximum, 32 pairs to qualify – 1 paired with 33, 2 with 34, etc; then 4BBB handicap matchplay.

Hutcheson Trophy

Three 18-hole rounds BB v par; choose own partners.

McIlraith Trophy

Eclectic competition; six 18-hole rounds nett as listed in the programme.

Summer Cup

Five 18-hole rounds nett; best four scores count.

Titahi Trophy

Three 18-hole rounds nett. Disc draw for partners after first round. Combined nett score.

Veterans' Trophy

One 18-hole round nett; for members aged 50 years and over.

Vice-Captains Trophy

Two 18-hole rounds stableford; hidden pairs combined total.

Shootout

Five best 18-hole rounds nett from the rounds programmed.

Crichton/Stone Alward/Booth Cup

Par Competition. Best 2 out of 3 rounds

Ken Douglas Trophy

One 18-hole round stableford; hidden pairs combined stablefords.
